4. Brief description of proposed project and explanation of why it is needed:

Provo Reservoir Canal Enclosure Project (PRCEP). The PRCEP would enclose the canal from 800 North near the mouth of Provo Canyon to the Point of the Mountain at its terminus. The canal delivers water to various irrigation and culinary users in Utah and Salt Lake Counties. Provo River Water Users Association (PRWUA) has for some time been studying ways to enclose the canal to increase public safety, reduce interference with canal operations, control water quality, reestablish the canal capacity, and reduce seepage and evaporation. Central Utah Water Conservancy District (CUWCD) has agreed to fund 1/2 of the project in exchange for the water saved from seepage and evaporation. (see attached project summary).


