

Does Salt Lake City honestly intend to build approx. 20 hydro-electric dams/plants in the canyons & valleys of Salt Lake County, and SLC's Metropolitan Water District build a 370 foot dam in Big Cottonwood Canyon, and a 410 foot dam in Little Cottonwood Canyon?

1908 SLC: "That there is no unappropriated water of Big Cottonwood Creek."
1914 SLC: "That all the waters of said creek [BCC] both primary water and surplus water, were fully and completely taken . . ."
1930 SLC: Big Cottonwood Dam bond voted down.
1950 MWD SLC: Report recommend BCC Dam to be constructed.
1963 MWD SLC: Files application to appropriate 60,000 for 370' BCC Dam.
1997 SLC: "There is no unappropriated water in this source [BCC]."
2003 MWDSLS: Updates title to 60,000 acre-feet water application for BCC dam.
2008 SLC: "Admit that the waters of Big Cottonwood Creek are fully appropriated. Admit."

If not, would the SLC water department make the public record clear by withdrawing these water applications?
